**\*New For 2010:** Clean Fuels Ohio will hold a recurring “Third Wednesday Webinar” Series. This regular series of webinars will provide two parallel course tracks covering an array of topics around biodiesel fuel and bio-based products for the transportation sector. These free webinar tracks are designed to provide information on specific subjects as well as offer a cumulative course for those who participate in each session. These webinars are presented with the generous support of the Ohio Air Quality Development Authority, the Ohio Soybean Council and the United Soybean Board. Details on each of the webinar tracks are as follows:

### Track 1: Biodiesel: Basics and Beyond

The “Biodiesel: Basics and Beyond” webinar track will provide a general yet comprehensive overview of biodiesel fuel and bio-based transportation products. The content in this track is designed to cover the range of biodiesel topics from feedstocks and production to practical applications and fleet use. Topics will include an overview of current feedstocks and production methods, ASTM standards and quality control processes, biodiesel’s mechanical and physical properties, case studies from successful fleet applications and information on advanced feedstocks. Industry experts and professional fleet managers will join Clean Fuels Ohio staff during each session to share their knowledge and experience. Whether learning about biodiesel for the first time or simply trying to stay on top of all of the latest developments in the industry, the “Biodiesel: Basics and Beyond” webinar track will have something to offer you.

### Track 2: ASTM Technical and Professional Series

The “ASTM Technical and Professional Series” is designed for audiences seeking more in-depth information on biodiesel related topics ranging from quality standards and engine maintenance to issues around handling, storage and Ohio specific use. The content in this track is designed to answer many of the technical questions that fleet managers and vehicle operators have posed during Clean Fuels Ohio’s past biodiesel events. Topics for this track will include a more detailed look at ASTM standards and BQ-9000 quality control programs, Ohio specific handling and use guidelines, information on vehicle maintenance and fuel additive packages, as well as presentations highlighting industry experts and successful fleet applications. Whether you’re a professional fleet manager or just an interested “gear-head,” the “ASTM Technical and Professional Series” webinar track is designed to address your questions and get you the answers you need to get going.
